

MINUTES FROM GREENHURST CRIME WATCH MEETING OCTOBER 20, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:05pm by the Treasurer. A motion was made and October minutes were accepted.

The Treasurer reported we have \$730 in our account.

The Secretary reported that an alert member spotted a garage sale sign on one of the new Sheriff's signs. He took it down. Members agreed that was the right thing to do.

The President reported no new problems.

The Webmaster reported he has updated the Narcotics report form on the website. It can be filled out online and emailed to Captain Decker at <mailto:JDecker@Dorchestercounty.net>.

The Webmaster withdrew his proposal to make a donation for our website domain.

Mr. Jay Byars, a personal friend of his, told him that the county will be closing on the Pine Trace property in November 2011. By the fall of 2012 a large part of the new park should be either nearing completion or already open. Included in this work, there is a grant money available to work on paving a walking/biking trail that will eventually go behind Greenhurst along the creek with the hopes of connecting with the Eagle Creek Trail in the future. As a part of the process, the ditches would need to be cleaned. This will be down the road into 2013 or beyond before it happens.

Captain Decker's report indicated 257 reports of crime in our region. The majority of the complaints in Greenhurst were on Braly and Bailey.

- There were 9 calls involving burglary, larceny, harassments/threats, assault, robbery, and vandalism.
- 2 calls on Wendy for destruction of property and family problems.
- 3 calls on Terry for CDV, false information and vehicle problem.
- Susan Dr. had a Domestic complaint. MV complaint on Lisa.
- Vandalism on Carmon, and CDV.
