

## **Minutes from September 20, 2012**

The meeting was called to order at 7:03. Members reminded the Secretary that the correct date of the minutes was 8/16/12. Minutes corrected.

### **Treasurer's Report:**

- We have a balance of \$756 on deposit. \$9 was reimbursed to Marina for the Fruit basket.

### **Secretary's Report:**

- The possibility of having a motorcycle show/ car show in the Parking lot before the National Night Out ride through the Neighborhood and perhaps some school supplies for the Greenhurst kids donated by churches or paid for by an entrance/donation fee from participants was raised by Marina. She will start checking on this right after Christmas.

### **Webmaster's Report:**

### **Old Business:**

- None

### **New Business:**

- Councilman Chinnis reported on a proposed firearms ordinance regarding regulating the discharge of firearms from public roadways in certain districts. You are not allowed to shoot from a truck or car. He and Captain Decker discussed the changes proposed and reassured us it did not ban owning firearms in our subdivision. Captain Decker stated that the "CASTLE DOCTRINE" still applied if the homeowner was being threatened by an armed attacker.
- The members were informed that the storm water fee has been cut by 30%.
- Discussion was also held about the noise ordinance mentioned last month. The Officer must hear the noise problem himself and this is unlikely because by the time he responds the offender is long gone. Capt. Decker said the homeowner can go to the Magistrates office and lodge a complaint and if found guilty a fine is involved.
