

MINUTES FROM JUNE 18TH CRIMEWATCH MEETING

The meeting was called to order at 7:04. There was no additions or corrections to the MAY 21ST meeting minutes.

Lt. Barnhill was present and gave the following information:

- An incident on May 25TH on Brailsfor Blvd. Damage to the door and lock. Forced entry, RX missing.
- Another call turned up expired license tags. If you spot this snap a photo and send to Sheriff's office.
- 928 Miles Rd. Search warrant for report of Criminal Sexual Conduct. No arrest.
- Due to high call volume it is recommended that you leave a light on in your home, close drapes, blinds so no one can peer in to see what you have, and if possible get an alarm system.

The Treasurer reported we have \$350 in our account. We agreed that we needed to do a small fund raiser at some point if we want to continue paying for mowing and upkeep on the center area.

The President had comments to make about possible fund raising in the future.

The Webmaster states that now is the time to keep harping on the state of our ditches because in case of a hurricane or even heavy rain we are at risk of flooding. He renewed our domain @ \$14.95/year. The hosting bill has been paid at \$85/year.

The Secretary complimented Monika Meeks for the lovely appearance of the Center. The Webmaster posted it on our website.

No Old Business was raised.

New Business included:

- Ideas for fund raising such as letting neighboring business's know they can post on our website and a fee was discussed.
- A bulk mailing was discussed and the question raised as to whether Miles Rd. Church could help us with this.
- Printing flyers at Staples was recommended as it is cheaper than doing it ourselves.
- The Secretary will look into any new small community grants available.
- Questions were again raised about the property at 916 Miles Rd, re: proper permits. (Secretary will inquire)
