

MINUTES FROM FEBRUARY 18TH, 2016 CRIME WATCH MEETING

The meeting was called to order at 7PM.

LT. Barnhill, DCSD was present and gave the following report: There were 2 incidents to note in our subdivision.

1. On 1/24, on Braly Dr. a drug violation involving cocaine. An arrest was made.
2. Later in the month a theft of \$660, I-pad, and Jewelry was reported on Braly Dr. The Saturation Team has been seen in our sub-division in the evening. The Sheriff's Dept. has been concentrating on high crime areas recently.

Treasurer's Report: Our current balance is \$295. Dave spent \$72 on a new light. It looks a lot better.

The Secretary asked about Ms. Susan Gillespie's current involvement in Crime Watch. Lt. Barnhill was not aware of any activity in that section of Greenhurst. The possibility of investing in another meeting notice sign for that section was raised but no action taken as yet.

Our President raised the issue of how much brighter the new light in the center is, especially when approaching Miles Rd. from Greenhurst Ave. The suggestion was to block the light on the back of the fence. The Treasurer stated he would assess the problem and take steps to mitigate the problem ASAP.

Our Webmaster reminded us the Domain name fee will be due in June.

Secretary: She reported she had taken a photo of Blackwell as you approach from Chalmers Lane, as there are big holes in the street there. The photos will go to Mr. Chinnis and County soon.
