

Minutes from May 19, 2016 GREENHURST CRIME WATCH MEETING

Meeting was called to order. There were no corrections or additions, a motion was made and seconded to accept the minutes as printed. Motion passed.

LT Barnhill was present to present his report of activity in the subdivision and answer questions from the members. He reported 4 incidents.

- April 27th a deputy on patrol stopped a driver on Braly Dr. He noticed a smell of marijuana; driver admitted smoking and was charged with possession.
- May 12th vandalism, car window found broken on Chalmers Lane.
- May 18th Braly Dr. traffic stop revealed drugs in vehicle.
- Also new residents at 100 Greenhurst reported their solar lights were stolen.

Lt. Barnwell discussed safety pointers for those going on vacation. Call Sheriff's office 843-873-5111 to request a Residence watch, and don't forget to call as soon as you return to cancel it. Don't post anything on social media about going away, or any video from security camera. Stop mail and newspaper.

Treasurer's Report: \$250. The lawn was mowed 2X this month.

President's Report: No problems in their area.

Webmaster's Report: Issue: We are NOT an H.O.A, (CRIMEWATCH) however it appears someone is renewing the original Covenants and this makes them enforceable. Check the website for more info.

Secretary's Report:

- The paving breakup at the corner of Chalmers Lane and Blackwell has been reported to Kathy Neals at DOT. There is allegedly a work order for this. My husband and I rode around the entire subdivision and noted about 5 other areas in poor condition. I will photograph them and send to Ms. Neals.
- The ditch parallel to Chalmers and Carmen has also been reported as needing cleaning out.
- PUBLIC WORKS 843-832-0070. I will be calling them monthly.
- A temporary sign has been placed on Miley and Judith (Greenhurst 2) to see if there is interest from the folks there in attending our meeting.

- Nick is checking on the cost of another sign. We do have the metal frame for it.
- The mess around the Sunshine store dumpster has improved. Do we need to follow up on this issue?

New Business: reports from members.

- 216 Greenhurst home empty and there is a pool. Kids observed running thru this yard.
- New family at 100 & 118 Greenhurst, 106 Chalmers and on Blackwell.
- RX type drugs appear to be sold @ 120 Greenhurst.

 - Answer: some are in unmarked vehicles but there are regular patrols especially in later hours when criminals are active.
