

MINUTES FROM OCTOBER 20th, 2016 MEETING:

Our Webmaster opened the meeting at 7:02PM. A Motion to accept minutes was accepted and seconded.

LT Barnhill opened his report by stating there had been no major problems in Greenhurst in the past 30 days.

- On 9/21 on Susan Dr. a report of Larceny, including theft of a lawn mower, weed eater, and Murray Lawn Mower.
- On the same day the Saturation team were working at a Brailsford Blvd /Terry Ave. address to investigate a report of drugs and equipment missing.
- On 10/1 on Susan another larceny involving theft of lawn equipment was investigated.
- On 10/06 the Saturation Team was again working on Terry Ave. and Braly Dr. stopping 3 subjects in hoodies, one of whom was in possession of a stolen gun.
- On 10/6 on Braly Dr. a vandalism report of parked car which had damage to rear window and side mirror.

Lt. Barnhill reminded the group that post hurricane there are often scammers about and to request photo ID from anyone coming to your door claiming to be from FEMA or Utility companies.

FEMA has opened an office across from Miles Rd. Baptist Church.

Treasurer's Report : estimated from last month \$ 495.

President's report: The Sheriff's sign reminding residents to lock their cars has vanished from the area by the Greenhurst sign. Lt. Barnhill took note of this.

Webmaster's Report: Hurricane damage in all areas of Greenhurst mostly limited to fallen trees and electrical power out for a few hours or a day. Some new problems on Carmon with cars with no plates and an 18 wheeler parking on the street and blocking one lane. We discussed the Carrington Chase situation but did not have much new to report. The Development is being advertised in TV already.

Secretary's Report: Fall decorations up currently, Halloween theme to follow. I hope to be planting some spring bulbs and pansies to take us through to Christmas. We will be doing this around the 10th of Dec. DOT finally repaired the Blackwell/Chalmers pot holes which were reported in March .

Old Business: Nick sent the Secretary a copy of the old Covenants and it appears that as they are written the Covenants automatically renew themselves. They seem to be in effect only for Greenhurst 3. Another member from Greenhurst 2 (Tina) said she has the Covenants for that area.

The Webmaster will be looking into more of the plan to connect our subdivision and Carrington via Bailey Dr. **FOR THE RECORD WE ARE NOT IN FAVOR OF THIS PLAN** because of the narrow roads, and certain increase of traffic into our subdivision.
