

MINUTES FROM JULY 20th MEETING

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 by Dave Williams. The members made a motion to accept the minutes as printed. The motion was seconded.

Deputy DeLong was our liaison from the Dorchester County Sheriff's Department.

- He made members aware of some recent changes in how sex offender's information is posted. The new system is designed to keep information up to date on line.

 - The first 6/21 on Braly Dr. was a civil disturbance.
 - The next one was on Brailsford June 20th. A breaking and entering with stolen lawnmower, string trimmer missing. Entry was through the back window.
 - On June 30th on Miles Rd .Jewelry, drugs and Marijuana were found during routine traffic stop.
 - July 5th Beau Ct. destruction of property, vandalism, and slashed tires was reported.

Treasurer's Report: We have \$445 in our account.

President's Report: no report as the Past President fell at the Barber Shop, had minor injuries.

Webmaster: Hits on our website remain at the same level. He noted home on Miles near Greenhurst has been observed burning household garbage. He noted that on his way thru the neighborhood there has been an increase in old TVs, couches, and mattresses. Piles of brush and a sofa were also observed on Blackwell and Chalmers. Marina volunteered to remind those folks about how to dispose of these things properly. Also noted a mattress at the opening to Eagle Creek. Marina will email Carol Thompson about this. Webmaster keeps in touch about the other problems. Marina also reported the property owner at 100 Carmon had 11 vehicles in his yard, most with paper tags.
