

MINUTES FROM JANUARY 18th meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 PM. The minutes were approved and seconded as printed.

Lt. Barnhill spoke next and reported the events since December.

- 12/22: Roberta Dr. A resident reported theft of \$900 cash, electronics, an Apple phone, and a package from the porch.
- 110 Bailey: reported discharge of a fire arm. Lt. Barnhill stated that we are in the unincorporated part of the county and there is no ordinance covering this problem. Several members felt it was a bad law and plan to address County Council in the future.
- 1/5: Burglary reported on Wendy way. No forced entry. Jewelry missing and a BB Gun and watch.

LT. Barnhill made a point of reminding all present about leaving purses and wallets in the car even when locked. There have been recent reports locally of broken windows and missing purses.

An officer from the traffic unit, Deputy Wasinack spoke to the members informing them that the law for speeding in CONSTRUCTION ZONES has increased and now can be as much as \$5000! He also referred to the distance to turn your turn signal is now 50 feet before the turn. We briefly discussed the problems with the roundabout and the storm. It was noted that the round about sign is down and lying in the grass at the top of the hill. (as of Jan. 31 it is still there)

Treasurer reported we have \$570 in funds but it is time to renew our web site which has increased since last year.

Our Webmaster also reported that the Gate is up and only first responders will be able to open it. There is a walking path alongside the gate. Nick reported about a dozen of the new homes had sold signs on them at Carrington Chase.
