

MINUTES FROM FEBRUARY 15TH MEETING

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm. The minutes were approved and seconded as printed.

Lt. Barnhill reported the events since January.

- 02/04: Braly Dr: theft from a building. While the resident was kept busy outside by someone posing as a pressure washer contractor, within 15 minutes two thieves stole \$5,570 in clothes, electronics, jewelry and money.
- 02/09: Wendy Way: domestic violence. Stolen items of \$670 including .22 rifle, shoes and 2 credit cards which were later used to charge purchases.
- 02/09: Braly Dr: Domestic dispute: damaged vehicle with several broken windows.
- Discussed the discharging of firearms in residential areas and indicated County Council is trying to pass an ordinance to stop it.
- The STOP sign at Bailey and Miles has been moved to allow visibility for the Crimewatch Area sign.

Treasurer: we have \$570 in funds not counting what is in the jar tonight.

President: Condolences were given to our President, Rita Scargill, regarding Bob's passing on February 14, 2018.

Webmaster: The cost to host the website has increased. If someone would like to setup a FaceBook page instead of the website that would be fine. Nextdoor will not work as well as the website or a FB page.

The Gate is up and connected. Only first responders will be able to open it using the sirens in their vehicles. There is a chain link fence at each end of the gate that pedestrians can walk around to get between Carrington Chase or Greenhurst. There will be two people from Dorchester Codes Enforcement at our next meeting.

Secretary: no report as she is at home recovering from surgery.

Old Business: there will be a County Council meeting in Council chambers in Summerville on March 5th at 7:00pm. This is a time for you to voice your comments concerning the proposed Firearms Discharge Ordinance. NRA is expected to be there in force.
