

MINUTES FROM MARCH 15, 2018 MEETING:

The meeting was called to order at 7:03. Minutes from February were reviewed and accepted as printed.

SHERIFF'S REPORT: Given by Lt. Barnhill.

- The first incident was 2/16 on Wendy way. A screen door was ripped off and a suspect entered the home stealing 2 TVs, \$1000 in cash, jewelry.
- On 3/7 at Braly a moped valued at \$1500 was stolen from the yard. It was purple and black.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Our current balance is \$455.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Discussion of the report in newspaper about the lack of ordinance which would prevent residents from discharging firearms in the unincorporated area of Summerville. This issue was raised at County Counsel after several complaints from Greenhurst residents.

WEBMASTER'S REPORT: There are still some problems with the gate at the end of Greenhurst Ave. & Bailey Dr. On one occasion a resident found the lock system was turned off.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: A reminder that election time is close. The position of Secretary/co-treasurer will be voted upon in June. Anyone wishing to run for this should make it known to the President in May. Webmaster asked about anyone aware of less expensive hosting for our website.

OLD BUSINESS: the second reading of the gun ordinance will be held at County Counsel meeting in April.

NEW BUSINESS: No new business
