

MINUTES FROM JUNE 20, 2018 MEETING

The meeting opened at 7:02 PM.

The minutes from last month were reviewed, two errors were corrected. A motion to accept corrected minutes was accepted.

SHERIFF'S REPORT: LT Napoli filled in for LT Barnhill who was out due to recent surgery. The following occurred since the last meeting:

- A female on Brailsford Blvd reported a gun stolen.
- There was a breach of trust – a moped was reported stolen, when a girlfriend borrowed the moped to go pick up some charcoal, then didn't return when expected. The moped was returned eventually. No charges.
- A theft was reported on Roberta Drive. Safe found open and unlocked. Medications stolen.
- White male with dark hair reported looking into parked vehicles. Not charged.

TREASURER'S REPORT: \$510 balance

WEBMASTER'S REPORT: Domain charges due to be charged on June 24th.

OLD BUSINESS: Halfway house on Terry Ave was checked out by the Sheriff's Dept. it is not run by the county. It is a private facility. The Webmaster said he would check with Councilman David Chinnis to let him know it is not connected with the county.

NEW BUSINESS: Parking on Bailey Dr. near the gate to Carrington Chase is becoming a problem. Many food delivery vehicles park there and walk through to make their delivery. The Webmaster said he would contact Councilman Chinnis about the possibility of getting NO PARKING signs put in place to alleviate the parking. LT Napoli informed us that unless there is signage stating no parking DCSD cannot charge anyone with parking in that area.

A crime watch member also reported that people (kids and adults) are pushing the gate open to get through with their bicycles.
