

MINUTES FROM JULY 19th 2018 MEETING

The minutes from the June meeting were reviewed and accepted. The meeting opened at 7:03 PM.

Lt .Napoli from DCSD Sat Team was present to give a report of incidents in our sub-division.

- 7/? : Susan Dr.: Burglary reported. Firearm and TV missing. Also on Susan, license plate stolen. Lisa and Brailsford: male reported running into ditch from law officer. He threw a bag containing drugs to the ground. His wallet was also found at the scene.
- 7/2: Judith: white male brown haired approached homeowner looking for a female "Christy". He was told no one by that name lived there. The homeowner went in rear yard to mow and later discovered he had been burglarized. Missing a cellphone.
- Susan Dr.: Burglary reported. Computer, TV, Laptop missing. No suspects.
- 7/8: Terry: motor vehicle theft.
- 7/14: Terry: victim attacked with a pvc pipe. Suspect charged with high and aggravated assault.
- Roberta: Answered a call at residence for males.
