

MINUTES FROM NOVEMBER 15th 2018

The meeting was called to order by our Webmaster. The minutes were reviewed and a motion was made to accept them as printed. This motion was seconded.

- Nov. 7th unknown person threw cinderblocks through the living room window and windows of 2 vehicles at Jack Ct.
- He reminded us of availability of residence checks if we were going out of town.

The Treasurer reported we had about \$480.

Webmaster reported that residents are still using our website to look up information and complain about issues such as cars speeding through the neighborhood.

Secretary reported there would be Christmas wreaths and lights up on our center area in December

Old Business:

New Business:

- It was reported that the Sunshine Food store was warned about the scaffolding and unregistered vehicle next to it.
- There are still problems with the Dumpster overflowing at the store, probably from the apartments nearby.
- One family reported that their solar panel installation was approved but according to Fire Marshal not installed to code.

Our guest this month was Mr. David Chinnis, County Councilman.

- Mr. Chinnis reported that the Miles Rd. Fire Dept . station will be moving down closer to the school and will include a Senior Center when built.
