

MINUTES FROM JULY 18th, 2019

The Meeting was called to order at 7PM. The minutes were seconded and approved.

SHERIFF'S REPORT: Lt. Barnhill reported 3 incidents in July.

- Theft from a motor vehicle at Roberta Dr. Owner reported loss of a Rolex watch valued at \$10,000 which occurred between 7/1 and 7/3.
- 7/3 on Bailey, Theft from unlocked MV of \$20 cash, a wallet, gift card and unfilled RX.
- 7/6 on Braly Ave, report of motor vehicle parts & accessories missing. Vehicle was from out of state and had been parked for about 2 weeks.
- 7/15 on Leroy Ct, reported missing drive shaft from 2000 GMC.
- Also reported missing items from home, intruders who left footprints from ditch area.

Treasurer reported a balance of \$500.

President remarked on height of grass as we currently have no designated person to mow the center.

Webmaster reported the Sheriff's Dept. now has the ability to view the recordings on home systems if homeowner requests this. There is increased use of our website. This may be due an influx of new, younger residents.
