

## **CRIMEWATCH MEETING MINUTES FROM JANUARY 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020**

The meeting opened at 7PM. Minutes was reviewed and a motion to accept the minutes as published was approved and seconded.

Lt. Barnhill presented his report. Incidents in Greenhurst from DEC-15<sup>th</sup> to JAN -15 TH were reviewed.

- 12/8/19 on Susan Dr. a report of a broken window in a vehicle and a 9mm handgun stolen from the vehicle.
- 12/11/19 a black Infinity auto which had been parked at 103 Dorchester Rd. for a month was keyed.
- 1/15/20 at Terry the owner of a vehicle reported her car had been keyed on driver side and hood.
- 1/15 a report on Bailey Dr. homeowner reported the motion sensor on porch went off and man was seen trying to get in a car parked in the yard. Homeowner has video.

Treasurer has \$540. We are still looking for a volunteer to mow and pick up trash at the Center.

President stated she had recently driven around the neighborhood and overall the properties looked good. No major property needing report to Code Enforcement.

Secretary reported a Silver Nissan parked by her mailbox with 3 persons inside on 1/3. The persons left after about 10 minutes. She will put up a valentine wreath at the center.

Webmaster reported a serious problem with the gate into Carrington Chase. On December 26<sup>th</sup> he was told by residents that the double gate was wide open. He investigated the problem and found one of the gates had been tampered with and bolts/ nuts had been removed. He was able to move one gate over but stated more mechanical work was needed.
