

CRIMEWATCH MEETING MINUTES FROM JULY 15, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 7PM by our Webmaster. Minutes from June meeting were not available.

SHERIFF'S REPORT: LT Martin reviewed the crime rate county wide last year and the first 6 months of 2021.

- The incidents of car thefts were down this year to 163. The decrease was likely to more people at home.
- Motor vehicle theft was 85 the second part of 2020 and in 2021 it was 66.
- Armed robberies and burglaries likewise were down.
- Homicides were up from 3 last year to 5 so far.
- Discussion was had about an unidentified man whose body was found in Greenhurst. This lead to discussion of the home on Terry St. and the type of persons housed there.
- LT. Martin also discussed the camps of homeless persons he is aware of in the County.
